AIMS of the Course

This course aims to examine human trafficking in India from interdisciplinary perspectives. It will help students to understand the historical trajectory of human trafficking, its various contours, nature and magnitude. Human trafficking is closely related to the study of social systems, social exclusion and inclusive policy, gender studies, poverty studies, and regional studies. Several scholars asserted that human trafficking could be considered as a form of modern slavery and organized crime that involves commercialization of human beings. Trafficking is one of the sole reasons for violating the fundamental human rights, and liberty of an individual. This course will examine the process of awareness campaigns, prevention, rehabilitation, repatriation and reintegration of the trafficked survivors. A special focus will be made on national and international policies and advocacy of human trafficking and the reasons for low conviction rate of the traffickers. This course will also highlight some relevant theoretical framework to understand human trafficking.
